

TRAE GRAY NAMED TO PRESTIGIOUS TRIAL LAWYERS' FORUMS



The Million Dollar Advocates Forum announced today that attorney Trae Gray of Coalgate has been certified as a life member of both the Million Dollar Advocates Forum and the Multi-Million Dollar Advocates Forum.

The Million Dollar Advocates Forum is recognized as one of the most prestigious groups of trial lawyers in the United States. Members of the Multi-Million Dollar Advocates Forum must be a Life Members of the Million Dollar Advocates Forum and must have acted as principal counsel in at least one case, which has resulted in a multi-million dollar verdict, award, or settlement. Mr. Gray has been approved for membership in both the Million Dollar Advocates Forum and the Multi-Million Dollar Advocates Forum.

Trae Gray is a natural resources trial lawyer with a nationwide practice focusing on oil and gas, water, condemnation, environmental, and other landowner related matters.

His academic credentials include a Juris Doctorate Degree and Masters in Business Administration Degree from Oklahoma City University. He also acquired a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources from Oklahoma State University, where he majored in Agricultural Economics. He is a 2014 candidate for an LL.M. Degree from The University of Oklahoma College of Law with a specialization in Energy and Natural Resources Law.
